

A comment from Mayor Jenkins

For the first time in all the years that I have attended conferences I feel the need to mention the obvious. Like many conferences, the four main conferences attended by Bancroft Council and Staff: Rural Ontario Municipal Assoc.(ROMA), Ontario Small Urban Municipalities (OSUM), Association of Municipalities of Ontario(AMO) and Ontario East Municipal Conference(OEMC) have trade shows. All four have sponsors to help offset the costs. At OEMC the large sponsors were as follows: Infrastructure Ontario, TransCanada Pipelines, Cambium Inc., Hydro One Networks, Foodland Ontario, Ontario Clean Water Agency (OCWA), Templeman Menniga LLP and Templeman Consulting Group, FarmBoy and Xplornet.
