

Local student selected for \$1,000 education scholarship

Another lucky Bancroft Tim Hortons employee has been selected to for the Tim Hortons Scholarship Program.

Seanna Dale from the Bancroft's Hwy 28 Tim Hortons applied to the scholarship program by writing an essay on how to inspire team members to do their best. It earned her one of the 220 scholarships of \$1,000 given out by Tim Hortons across the country.
